During the pandemic anti-scientific voices have become more strident on social media and there have even been hate crimes directed at scientists. Avoidance of scientific evidence and reasoning has also become evident as an aspect of vaccine hesitancy and objections to other public health interventions. There has been a troubling overlap between these phenomena and faith-related beliefs, with indications that faith can be used to justify or harden them. The afternoon session		

will offer an opportunity to explore the reasons for science avoidance in faith communities and reflect on ways to address the issue with Dr Joanna Collicutt.
