

Prompt: Rules and regulations of the Katha:

- 1. Dress code: It is important to dress modestly and respectfully. Shoes will need to be removed when entering religious areas.
- 2. Purity: It is important to maintain physical and mental purity while attending the Katha. This may include taking a shower before the event, and avoiding non-vegetarian food or alcohol before attending.
- 3. Respect for idols and sacred objects: Treat idols, images, and sacred objects with respect and refrain from touching them without permission. Make offerings and perform rituals with proper reverence.
- 4. Silence and focus: Maintain a quiet and focused mindset during prayers, rituals, and ceremonies. Avoid unnecessary talking or distractions.
- 5. Follow instructions: Follow the instructions of the priests, elders, or event organisers regarding specific rituals, prayers, and customs.
- 6. Non-wastage: Avoid wastage of food, water, or other resources during the event. Consume prasad (blessed food) with respect and gratitude. Follow clean and clear policy all the time.
- 7. Photography and video recording: take these discreetly and in a way that does not get in the way of others.
- 8. Donations and offerings: If you wish to make donations or offerings, do so respectfully and follow the procedures designated for such acts.
- 9. Kindness and politeness: Always be kind and polite to others. Do not talk during the Katha.

Remember, it is always best to inquire about specific rules and regulations from the organisers of the Katha.

- All bookings are non-refundable and non-transferable.
